Mommy's Light shines on



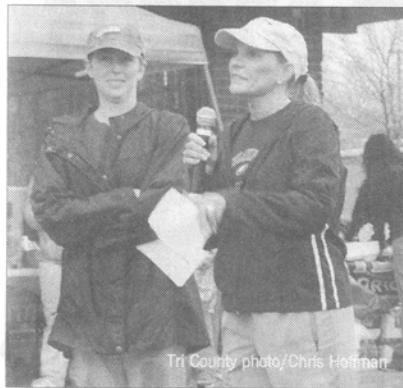
