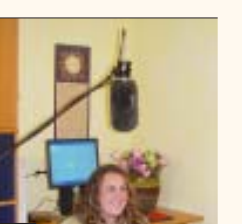

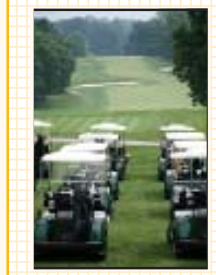

As a result of national recognition in *People Magazine*, Mommy's Light received requests for services and information from around the country and provided much-needed support through materials

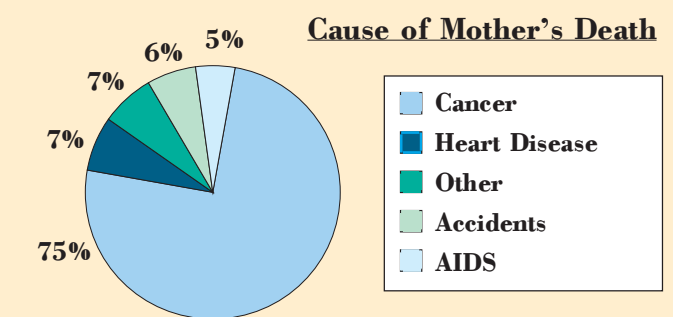
on our web site. We also distributed more than 5,000 bereavement brochures and information packages throughout the Delaware Valley.

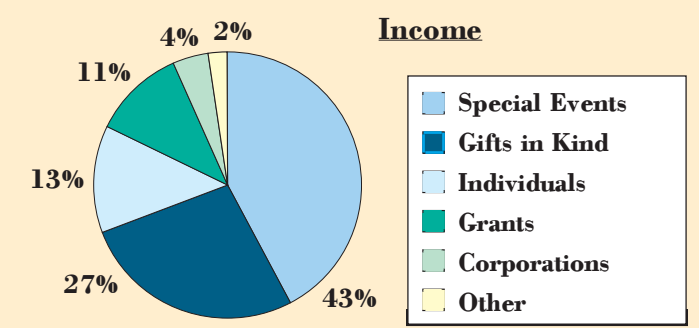

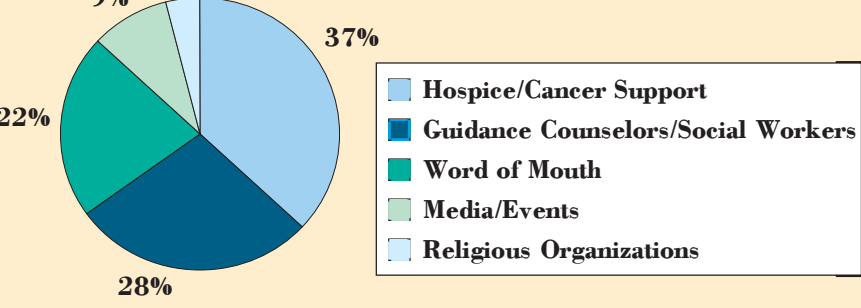

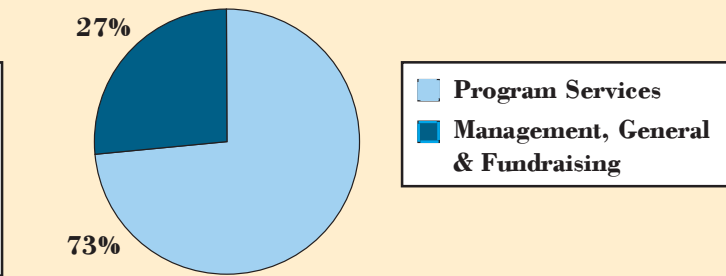

Excerpts from Alexis DiClemente's speech on November 4, 2006 at Mommy's Light's 3rd Annual Night of Stars:

My name is Alexis DiClemente and I am 16 years old, as of today. I am a junior at Merion Mercy Academy and I live in Drexel Hill with my dad and my 11-year-old sister, Emily. My mom, Sharon, passed away on October 19, 2003 from breast cancer, after her three year valiant battle. Shortly thereafter, we were introduced to Mommy's Light.

Former British Prime Minister Harold Macmillan once said, "Tradition does not mean that the living are dead, it means that the dead are living." I deem this to be true because through Mommy's Light, my mom's spirit and memory are kept alive by continuing the traditions that she began. I feel very appreciative towards everyone at Mommy's Light and I thank them for giving me the gift of tradition.

My favorite tradition is going to see the Nutcracker ballet every Christmas season. My mom started taking me to see the production when I was a little girl and we went together every year. Since she is not able to take me anymore, Mommy's Light has undertaken the responsibility of making my holiday special. They provide me with the opportunity to enjoy a night in the city with my dad and sister, beginning with dinner, then onto the show.

Our visits with the Mommy's Light volunteers, especially Tracey, Julie, and Jill, are also very special to my sister and me. The ladies always come bearing gifts, their smiles, and their friendship. They consider every aspect of the visit including miniscule details such as the color of wrapping paper and the surprise trivia games. Mommy's Light provides me with both joy and comfort knowing that such a wonderful organization cares enough to help me and many other children celebrate our moms.

On behalf of my dad and sister, I would once again like to express my gratitude towards the entire Mommy's Light organization. I am so proud and lucky to be a recipient of the benefits from this organization. Although a mother's love can never be replaced, Mommy's Light helps to fill a void in my heart in which I hold dear the traditions that my mom started.
